**EXAMINATION INFORMATION**

Examination Date and Time: Wednesday, February 7th, 2018 at 6:00 pm.

Examination Location: Norwood High School Cafeteria 2020 Sherman Ave. Norwood, OH 45212.  
The examination will take approximately 2 hours. Each applicant is required to present valid photo identification for admission to the examination.

Applicants must be:

- at least twenty-one (21) years of age and no older than thirty-five (35) years of age at time of appointment and attending an Ohio Police Officer Basic Training Academy at time of Examination Date.

Or

- currently commissioned as a Law Enforcement Officer in Ohio. Maximum Age restrictions for commissioned Law Enforcement officers are waived.

Applicants must receive a minimum passing grade of seventy percent (70%) on the written test, prior to receiving any additional credit. Candidates passing the written test shall be required to undergo a physical and/or complete an agility test, polygraph test, and psychological testing. Applicants must successfully pass all tests.

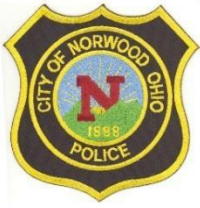
In order to receive Military Veterans Credit: 20%, 4 Year College Degree: 10%, 2 Year College Degree: 5%, Ohio Certified Police Officer: 10%, the applicant must present acceptable proof of such at the time the application is submitted. The maximum special credit points will not exceed 20%. A minimum passing grade of 70% is required before any special credit points will be added to the applicant's base score.

**NPD Background History Statement** can be printed from the NPD website link above and MUST be submitted no later than February 7th, 2018 at 6PM prior to being seated for Examination. Proof of all other additional credit must be submitted with Application.

The applicant must also be willing to submit to the following: Norwood Police Physical Agility Test, Computer Voice Stress Analyzer (CVSA), Background Investigation, Interview Panel, Mayor and Safety Director Interview, Chief's Interview, Psychological Evaluation, Medical Examination, (including drug test).

NPD policy strictly prohibits tattoos that cannot be covered with the standard uniform, or body piercings that are visible when wearing the standard uniform.
